### WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

A Level Photography (Film & Moving Image) is a well-established course for students interested in the creative industry and the possibilities of film and animation. The course allows students to work in a very practical way whilst developing skills and understanding required to produce their own professional outcomes and a portfolio.

At the beginning of their studies, they will be introduced to a variety of techniques through workshops to build up a broad range of skills, before embarking on personal projects that give them the freedom to explore their individual style of filmmaking. This course will build confidence in written and practical work to prepare them for university and employment.
